Provided that upon a request by the entrepreneur, further extension may be granted by the Development Commissioner for valid reasons to be recorded in writing for a further period not exceeding two years”

Provided further that the Development Commissioner may grant further extension of one year subject to the condition that two-thirds of activities including construction, relating to the setting up of the Unit is complete and a Chartered Engineer’ Certificate to this effect is submitted by the entrepreneur:”

[Provided also that the Board of approval may, upon a request in writing by the entrepreneur, and after being satisfied that it is

d) Other Information:-

M/s. Soni Polymers Pvt. Ltd. was issued LOA No. Mihan-Sez/Unit-02/LOA-03/AM-2022 dated 02.08.2021 for exports of manufacturing i.e. Glue Stick, Correction Fluid, Correction Pen, Markers, Stamp Pad at Plot No. 4L, Sector-18, MIHAN-SEZ. The initial validity of the LOA was for a period of one year from the date of issue of the LOA. The LOA was further extended upto 01.08.2023 vide Letter Ref No. SEZONLINE/INKRM3/192300000336 DATED 21.04.2023. The LOA was again extended for a period upto 01.08.2024 vide Letter Ref No. SEZONLINE/INKRM6/1923000001320 dated 13.09.2023 in terms of Rule 19(4) of SEZ Rules, 2006.

On scrutiny of details, it may noticed that the validity of the Letter of Approval dated 02.08.2021 has expired on 01.08.2024. The unit did not applied for extension of LOA before expiry of validity of the LOA.

M/s. Soni Polymers Pvt. Ltd. vide SEZ Online Request Id. 192500003953 dated -29.11.2025 and letter dated 02.12.2025 and 09.12.2025 has requested for extension of validity of Letter of Approval. The Unit has stated that due to USA tariff sanction decision and other related issues there was delay in machinery import and raw material import hence, they need to shift some machineries from their Hingna plant to MIHAN-SEZ Unit to start production process, they are unable to apply for extension before expiry date.

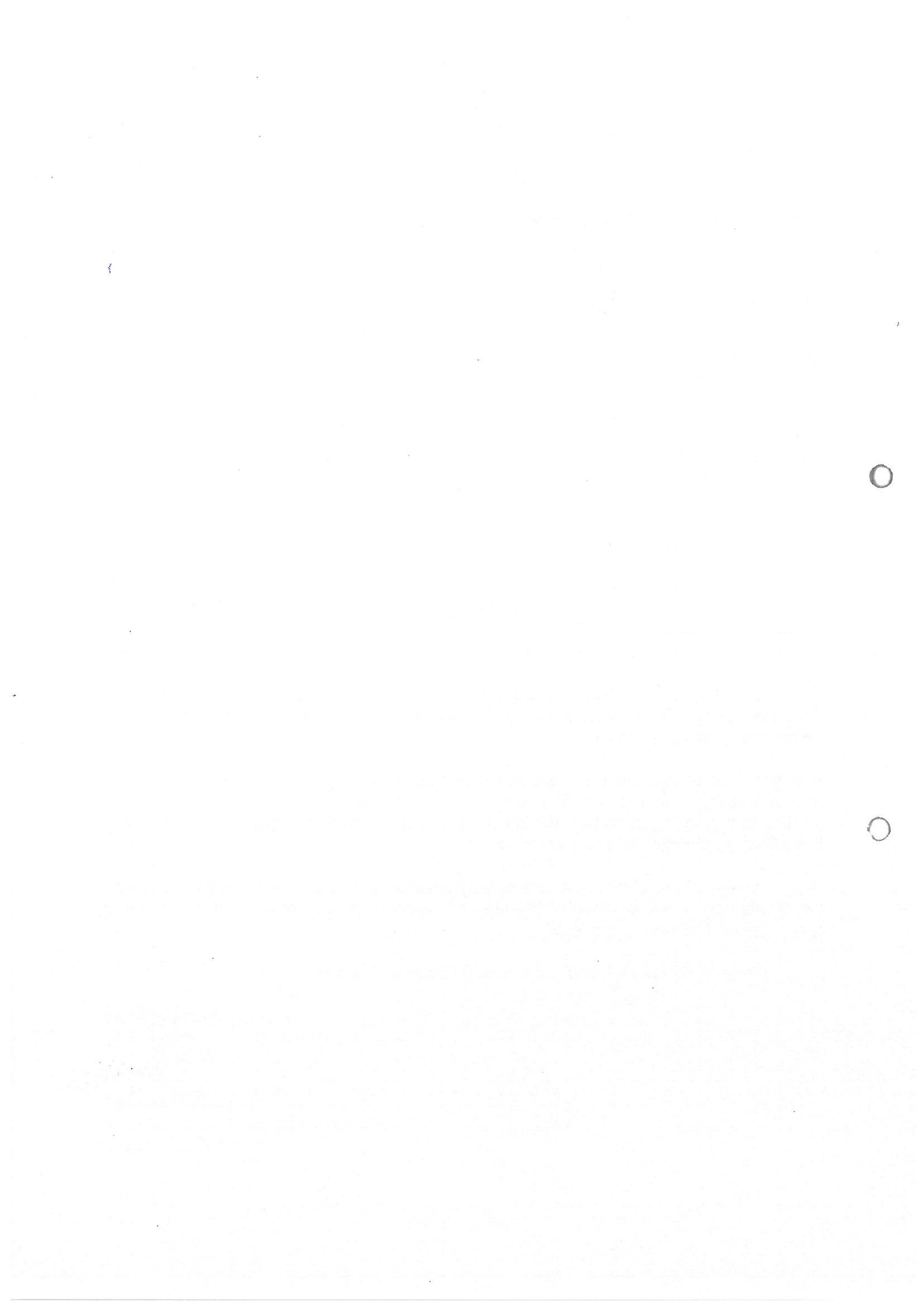

The proposal of M/s Dassault Reliance Aerospace Ltd for change of Shareholding pattern was placed before the Approval Committee in its meeting held on 14.07.2025. The Committee after detailed deliberation granted in-principal approval for change of shareholding pattern based on the declaration submitted by the firm has per Instruction no. 109. The Unit shall also give an undertaking that they are not operating and shall not operate going forward in the defense sector without prior approval of the Government since they understand that as per extant FDI policy defense sector has separate rules for foreign ownership. The Committee has directed that the transaction related to payments involved for the change of shareholding pattern shall be completed within 90 days from the date of issuance of the minutes of this meeting and shall be reported within that time. Committee also decided that the matter be brought again to the Committee when the RBI/FEMA related compliances are over for registering the ownership change.

Accordingly, this office vide letter No. MIHAN-SEZ/UNIT/DRAL/03/2017-18 dated 24.07.2025 granted in-principle approval for change of shareholding pattern with the conditions imposed by the Approval Committee.

The Unit vide letter dated 29.07.2025 has undertaken that they are not operating and shall not operate going forward in the defense sector without prior approval of the Government.

Further the unit vide letter dated 29.09.2025 informed that the transaction related to payments involved for the change of shareholding pattern of DRAL has been duly consummated and completed between the existing shareholders of DRAL.

The Unit now vide letter dated 10.12.2025 has stated that the transaction related to payments involved for the change in shareholding pattern referred to in the Approval Letter has been undertaken within the timeline of 90 days and confirm that the company has completed RBI/FEMA related compliance for registering the change of Shareholding pattern/Ownership change of DRAL vide application bearing reference number FC_TRS1025112107.
