

MERC on the project, they could not implement the project after 2014-15 onwards. Their Lender approached the NCLT for recovery of dues under Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code. NCLT has accordingly ordered the liquidation vide order dated 31.08.2018 and appointed the Liquidator in the matter. The Committee noted that the unit failed to achieve Positive NFE on cumulative basis during the block period 2013-14 to 2017-18.

The Committee directed that Specified Officer shall ascertain the liability/dues to be recovered from the unit and file application before Liquidator immediately.

Agenda No.10- Monitoring of Performance of M/s. Air India Ltd. for the period 2015-16 to 2018-19.

It was informed to the Committee that verification of data is yet to be received from the Specified Officer. The Committee, therefore deferred the proposal.

Agenda No.11- Application of M/s. Kolland Developers Pvt. Ltd. (Co-Developer)- Approval of Lis of Goods required for authorized operations.
